We at H₂Rover sincerely thank you for buying one of our water bottles. Our unique bottle design allows you to water your dog using the hose and tap attached to the bottom of the bottle. You can still drink safely and hygienically from the top.

Your new bottle is hand built using the highest quality stainless steel parts and FDA approved food grade materials, and should provide you and your dog with trouble free hydration for a long time.

Assembly Instructions

If you received your H2Rover packaged in a box, you'll need to spend a minute assembling it. Otherwise, you can skip this section.

- 1. Remove the bottle, clear plastic hose & spigot from the box.
- 2. Attach the end of the clear hose to the metal fitting on the bottom of the bottle by pressing it on firmly.
- The dispensing tap is shipped in the "open" position. Flip the tap handle sideways to move it to the "closed" position before filling the bottle.
- 4. Ensure the threaded "cap" of the tap valve is tight.
- 5. Unscrew the bottle lid, and remove the shoulder strap from inside.
- 6. Attach the shoulder strap to the carabiner clip.
- 7. Fill it up and take your dog for a walk!

Proper Care of your H2Rover Water Bottle

- Wash all parts in warm, soapy water before use.
- Your H2Rover bottle is not microwave safe. You will not be pleased with the results if you try.
- The plastic parts of your H2Rover bottle are not dishwasher safe. Hand wash only.
- Not for use with hot liquids. We don't think dogs like coffee anyway.

Using your H2Rover Water Bottle

Your bottle uses a gravity feed system. For the water to dispense properly, the bottle's lid MUST be popped open, and the dispensing tap MUST be below the bottom of the bottle.

The bottle's carrying strap is designed to be worn diagonally over your shoulder. The bottle hangs under the opposite shoulder. The length of the strap is designed to carry the bottle slightly above your hip, which should allow you to dispense water at a comfortable arm's reach.

How do I store the hose and tap while I'm walking?

There are two good ways to store the hose and tap while you're walking, to prevent the hose from swinging around:

- The most secure way is to "pinch" the last few inches of hose underneath the flip-top lid.
- A quicker way is to hook the tap handle inside the plastic carrying loop on the bottle from the bottom.



We've found that both of these hose storage techniques work quite well. Choose your favorite.



How do I train my dog to drink from the water stream?

If your dog doesn't instinctively lap from the stream, you can start by pouring from the tap into your hand, or into a small cup. When they start lapping, start the stream flowing into your hand/cup to get them used to it. Gradually over a few sessions, you should be able to start moving the container away, and get your dog lapping exclusively from the stream of water.
